Uist Community Riding School is a community-run project that offers all sorts of equestrian activities for locals and visitors to the islands. These include beach rides and paddles, lessons with qualified instructors, longer hacks, own-a-pony days for children, an annual camp and a show – plus much more. The school is the only riding establishment in the Outer Hebrides to be approved by the British Horse Society.

Loch Druidibeg National Nature Reserve (South Uist) is the perfect place for bird-watching. Well-known for its breeding greylag geese, the reserve is

also good for wildfowl and waders.
